

Postcard from home project is expressed by artistic action of Polish and foreign Academies of Fine Arts communities and academic societies that collaborate with them. Despite the pandemic, freeze of cultural events and activities and despite mobility restrictions we encourage you to meet because **we are here, we support each other and we want to react.**

From their homes and ateliers, the project participants are to send two-sided works of A5 format (which refers to greeting cards or traditional postcards—image and text) in a digital form which will create a virtual, accessible gallery on the website of the Salon Akademii Gallery of the Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw. The postcards would be, therefore, addressed to all authors but at the same time they can be addressed to a specific person to establish a dialogue between the works. Works can be made using any technique: drawing, painting, graphics, digital or photography. After the period of “virtual quarantine” and as soon as the situation allows, the printed Postcards from home will be presented at the Salon Akademii Gallery and then in other academic and cultural institutions that cooperate with us.

It is important for us to that the Postcard from home project is participated by students of the Academies, post-graduate students and all interested staff but also by friends of our academic community. Our initiative should become a record of this exceptional time and expression of relations between artists, of openness and active participation in social life.
